### *Driving Directions to Franklin Pierce Law Center:*

From the South:

Follow I93 to Exit 14 - Turn left (west) at the light at the end of the Exit 14 ramp onto Loudon Road (Centre Street). Proceed .8 miles to the junction of Centre and Washington Streets. Turn right onto Washington Street and proceed to the Law Center. Parking is available just past the school in lots adjacent to the Washington Street Café at the corner of Rumford and Washington Streets.

From the North:

Follow I93 to Exit 14 - Turn right (west) at the light at the end of the Exit 14 ramp onto Loudon Road (Centre Street). Proceed .8 miles to the junction of Centre and Washington Streets. Turn right onto Washington Street and proceed to the Law Center. Parking is available just past the school in lots adjacent to the Washington Street Café at the corner of Rumford and Washington Streets.

Parking: There is on-street parking on Washington and White Streets (same side as White Park) and Law Center Parking Lots (no charge) on the same side of the street as the Law Center.

**ENTRANCE: WORKSHOP PARTICIPANTS SHOULD ENTER THROUGH THE WASHINGTON STREET ENTRANCE (BEFORE THE WHITE PILLARS - THE NEWER SECTION OF THE BUILDING).**
