



Questions the Judges May Ask You....

General questions:

1. How did you get the idea for your invention?
2. How did you make it?
3. Did you keep a log?
4. May I see your log?
5. What was the biggest problem you faced while working on your invention?
6. Did you have to change your original idea in any way?

Invention:

1. What is the name of your invention?
2. How does your invention work?
3. Who will benefit from your invention?
4. Why do you think your invention is new and original?

Rube Goldberg® Machines:

1. What is the name of your machine?
2. What ordinary task does your device accomplish?
3. Describe how your machine works by listing at least 6 steps?
 - a. What happens at each step?
4. What simple machines were used?

(These are just a few of the questions that a judge may ask you – you may be asked to answer other questions, as well.)
